

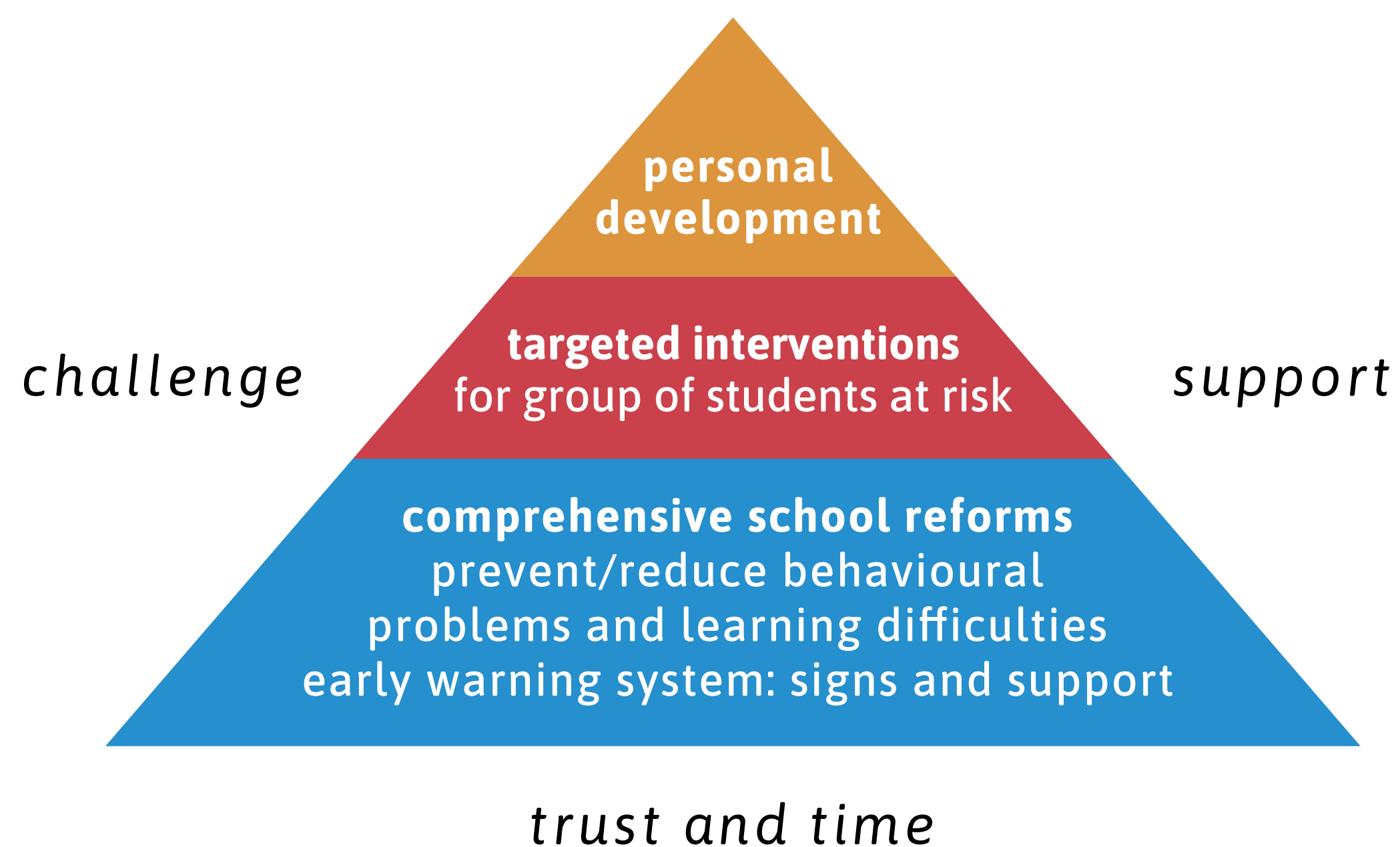

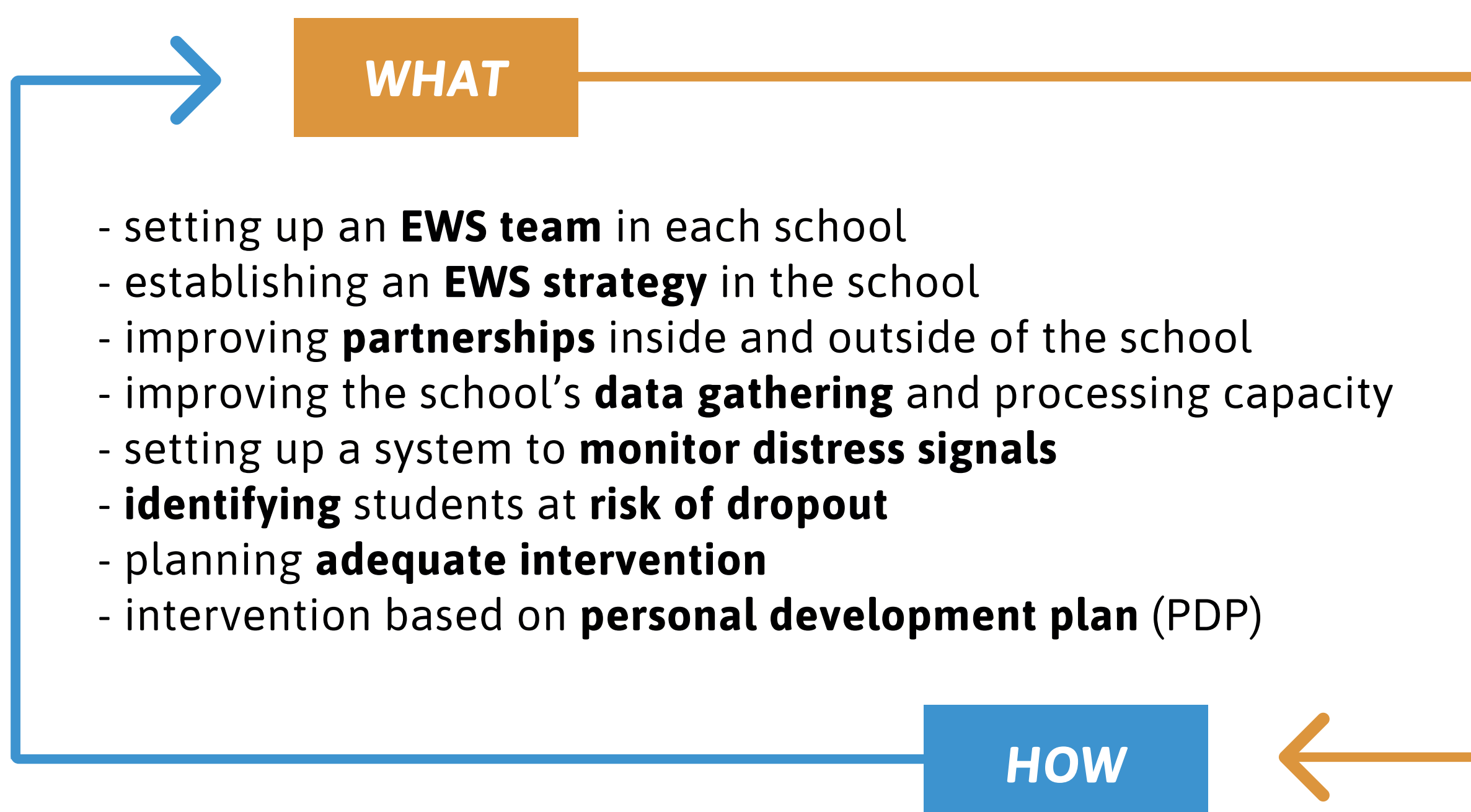
## CroCooS – Cross-Sectoral Cooperation Focused Solutions for Preventing Early School Leaving

**CroCooS – Prevent dropout!** (2014-2017) project identified elements of a comprehensive institutional **early warning system (EWS)** and tested its applicability in national context. The **CroCooS Knowledge Centre** is a complex system linking closely the **Resource Pool** with a huge theoretical background, the **CroCooS Toolkit** with several tools could be used in the school to prevent dropout and the **Guidelines** to support the effective usage of the Toolkit with thematic tags.

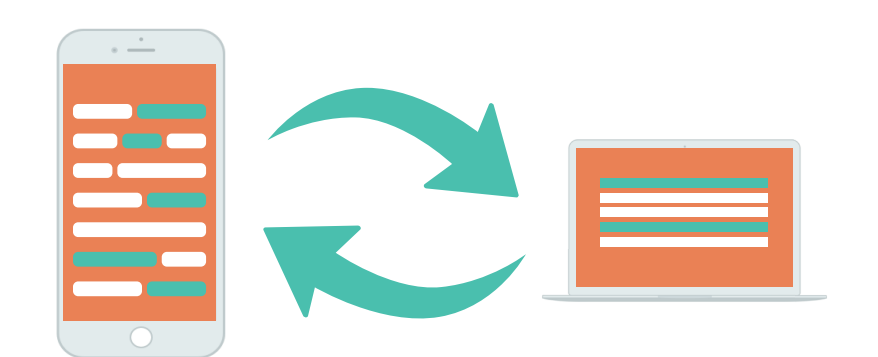
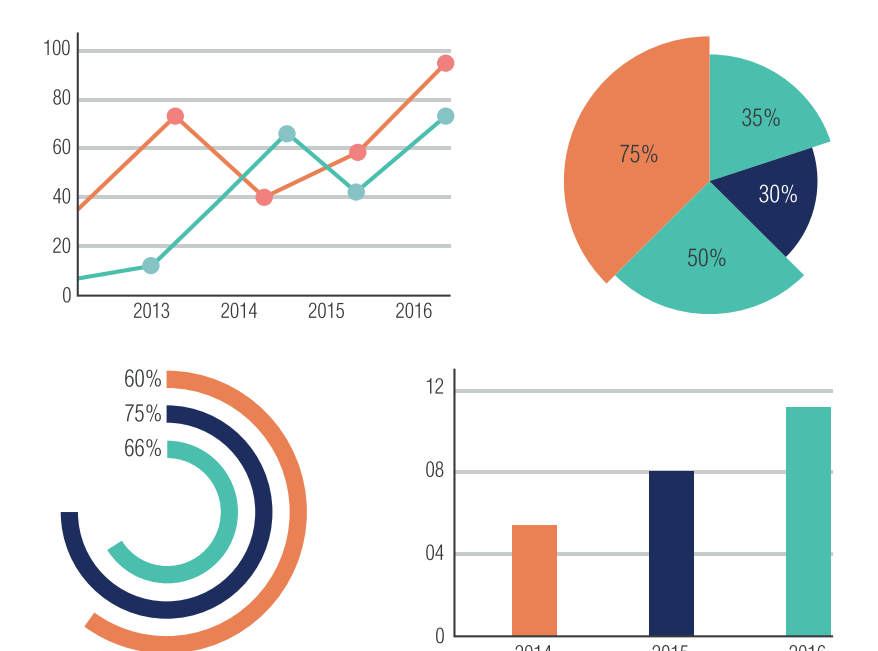
